

Training: Preparing Managers for Fundamental Changes to Unfair Dismissal



The Employment Rights Act 2025 ('**ERA 2025**') represents one of the most significant changes to UK employment law in decades. From January 2027 the qualifying period for unfair dismissal will reduce from two years to six months and compensation will be uncapped. In addition, from October 2026, employers will face expanded duties to take all reasonable steps to prevent sexual harassment in their workplace and to prevent harassment by third parties on any grounds.

The risk profile has changed and managers will need to take a much more proactive approach to probation, performance, conduct and documentation.
